This will verify your reception of radio station KXXL on the morning of Feb. 5. Your record of our transmitted signal appears to be quite accurate.

Thank you for your interest and for our signal report. We are modulating the transmitter by means of a relatively new device called an "Audio Pilot." This unit prevents any negative overmodulation while permitting the positive half cycle to go up to as much as 120%!

Good listening. I note you have a good receiver, how is the HQ-129-X on single sideband--or don't you bother with that much?
