
Dear Sir,

Thank you for your letter reporting reception of our programme on 1457 kc/s on 24th February.

The information about the programmes broadcast agrees with the material which we were broadcasting at the time and it appears therefore, that it was indeed one of our transmitters which you heard. It is difficult to say which of our stations it was that you heard as we operate our medium wave stations as synchronised groups. However, as you will see from the enclosed blue folder the Clevedon transmitter is the most likely one that you heard as it is the most powerful one of the group.

We are glad to confirm your identification of the programme but regret we do not operate a QSL card service for our medium wave services.
