

Dear Sir,

Thank you for your letter postmarked 15th December and reporting reception of our station on 1340 kc/s on Monday, December 14th.

From the information about the programmes which you heard we confirm that it was indeed one of our transmitters which you heard. As you are probably aware we have two transmitters working on 1340 kc/s, but the Lisnagarvey station is far more powerful than the Londonderry station and was probably the one you heard. We regret we do not operate a QSL card service for our domestic broadcasting stations but are always glad to confirm reports of their reception. For your interest we are enclosing a copy of the Northern Ireland edition of Radio Times, the programme journal of all the BBC's broadcasts.
