your reception of CBNC, Stephenville, Newfoundland.


CBNC is a 40 watts low power relay transmitter

- (3) Port aux Basques, CBNE, 1370 Kc/s.

- (5) Wabush (Labrador), CBND, 1240 Kc/s.

I trust this reply answers your questions.

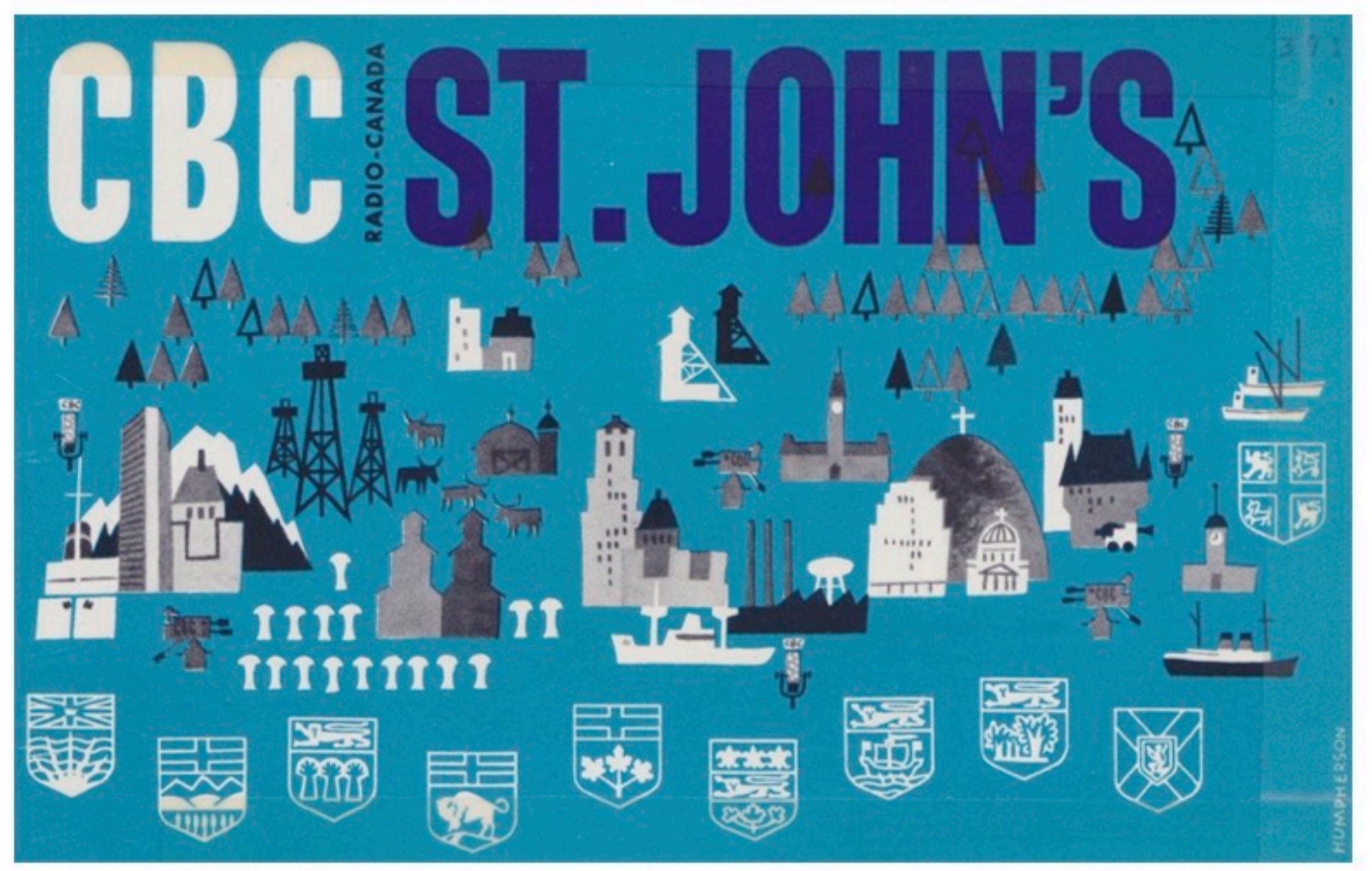
