This will verify your reception of CJET between 10:13 PM and 10:30 PM on November 19th, 1962.

At the time in question, we were using our RCA BTA-1M 1 Kilowatt transmitter driving a phase unit which in turn drives three 306 foot towers, placed 90 electrical degrees apart, in a straight line 168 degrees East of true North. The resultant pattern is as shown on our old coverage map.
