RADIO BARBADOS is operated by the Caribbean Broadcasting Corporation, a Government statutory board. It is a commercial broadcasting station designed to serve Barbados and the Leeward and Windward Islands. It is managed by the Thomson Television (International) Ltd. Consortium and is served by Television International Enterprises, Ltd. as international sales representative.

RADIO BARBADOS will go directional on January 20, 1964, to concentrate our signal in a North-Northwestern direction. At that time we will also begin broadcasting 17 hours a day from 6:00AM to 11:00PM (AST)


