We're happy to send you verification of your reception Sunday morning, December 2nd, 1962 of the special DX program conducted by WBLF.


Reports came from Michigan, Illinois, Ohio, New York, New Jersey, Connecticut, Canada, Massachusetts, Rhode Island and, of course, Pennsylvania. Most everyone complained of a loud overtone and the Cuban 1330.

WBLF went "on the air" August 1, 1958 and has been using 1330 with 500 watts ever since. We're a daylighter at WBLF and program "Pop" music using a rather fast pace. Tower height is 210 feet.

There's good reason why some of you couldn't get the station prior to 4:30 AM. We weren't on! Filaments are set to go on automatically at 4:30 AM and no one thought to set the time up in order for the transmitter to be ready to go at 4:00 AM. For this reason we've scheduled another test Sunday morning December 23rd from 4:00 to 5:00 AM. Be sure to let all of your DX friends know about this new test for WBLF.
