studios & transmitter on Highway Hill in Bennington.
We invite you to join us tomorrow morning at 6:30
for the news & "Morning Almanac" program. On behalf
of the staff & behalf of myself ... (you faded out
at this time & I was unable to hear any more from
WBTV.)

quite some time, too.


