
This is to verify your reception of Radio Station WCNR,

WCNR operates on a sunrise to sunset schedule with a
power of 1000 watts non-directional, a frequency of
930 Kilocycles, and a wave length of 323 meters, since 1947.
All equipment, including the transmitter, is manufactured
by Raytheon.

The studio and offices are located in the center of
Bloomsburg, 38 West Main Street. The transmitter is
located two miles east of Bloomsburg between the communities
of Espy and Light Street.
