I was quite pleased to hear station WDXN broadcasting on a frequency of 540 kcs. Programming I heard was as follows:

- 5:42 ad from Ajap Distributor
- 5:25 Start of the news final, presented by the Northern Bank
- 5:25 1/2 News
- 5:28 ad for the Bank
- 5:28 1/2 Weather forecast
- 5:29 End of news - then "Dipie." Then came WDXN's sign off announcement. It was announced that WDXN would re-tune at 7 AM in the morning
- 5:30 WDXN left the air with "Dipie"
