Dear John,

Thanks for your I.W.I. report as it has helped me determine our night skip pattern.

The transmitter here is a Bauer 1KW rig using 4-400 A's in the final in parallel and push pull in the Modulator. The remote r. f. ammeter is made by I T A as well as the "stay-level" and frequency monitor. I also made our modulation monitor. The antenna is an end fed, $\frac{1}{4}$ wavelength, guyed, insulated, vertical made from Rodn # 25-6 sections; 150 ft. high. The control board is an all transistorized version by R.C.A.

Thank you again for your report and we will go into operation full time during the day on the 7th of this month
