Very glad to hear from you and to know that you receive our station there in New Jersey. Very fine logging that you have done. Very pleased to have the signal report as we are only running 250 watts on as sunup to sundown schedule.

We have a 154 foot tower at Weston Place at Shenandoah Pa. at an elevation of approximately 1450 ft. Running 250 watts into the vertical antenna with a Westernelectric transmitter Gates console and Gray turntables.

It is indeed a pleasure to hear from you and to know that WMBT is being received in your town. We began our daily broadcasting on March 19, by permission of the F.C.C. that day.
