Your report is correct--the program at 5.30PM was the Childrens Bible Class, a live program from our studio followed at 5.45P.M. by the Bible Talks a Christian Science transcribed program... WNLK was operating with a power output of 1000 watts with our new 20V-3 Collins transmitter and we are certainly pleased at the nice job it is doing. Your chances of hearing us at night-time (after local sunset) is very remote because we are 2 tower directional then and radiate in your direction the equivalent of approx 10 watts. Are operating sked-Daily- 6am-10PM. (soon 11PM.) Sun.-8am-8PM.

P.S.-Our reg Quarterly Freq. Check with Boston is held at 12.30A.M.- Apr., July, Oct., and Jan.- on the 1st Mon. morning.
