This letter will verify your logging of the WQSR broadcast.



WQSR, a 500 watt, directional (SE) station serves Syracuse from Solvay on a daytime basis (EDT 6 AM - 8 PM) only.

Frankly, we were quite happy to learn of your reception since Freehold is some 300 miles. However, there are several reasons why you experienced interference in reception. As you know, stratospheric changes will affect skywave transmission during the day particularly at dawn and dusk. Secondly, any station (500 watt or less) at the same or an adjacent frequency will cause interference. In addition to the foregoing information, Freehold may be at, or near, the geographical perimeter of our coverage pattern.
