Dear Mr. Sampson:


This is to acknowledge receipt of and thank you for your letter of November 26, 1962, requesting verification of reception of Radio Station WSUX, Seaford, Delaware.

The first part of your report dealing with march music and station I. D. repeated twice is correct, the 1000 cps. tone ~~not~~ 500cps. tone were not used. We were testing a newly installed modulation transformer with the march music which of course has varying modulation effects.
