WVOB is a fairly new station - we have been on the air just about two months now, and in that time we have heard from a great many DXers.

WVOB operates on 1520 Kilocycles, with a power of 250 Watts daytime and non-directional. We have had very good luck with our signal, and have not too much interference here. We do have a little trouble at sign-on and just before sign-off with WKBW. But the fact you were able to copy us at all at that distance shows we are getting through.
