Mr. Sampson;

I will confirm your reception of KBMR on September 9, 2000. The only discrepancy I find in the content is in your quotation. I can see the confusion if the reception was indeed marginal. It should be " The Morning *MUG*, Charlie *WILLIAMS* on Country 1130 KBMR. " All else is correct.

The station is located on the East edge of Bismarck and it is a 10,000 watt daytime only station. The transmitter is a Harris DX10 and the antenna is a single non-directional tower of 86 degrees and 120 equally spaced radials.

I know your area well. I am sorry that I don't recall having met you before. I lived in Grand Rapids from April 1972 until November 1990. In the mid 70's I built the house at 805 Clover Lane (right behind Pizza Hut), raised 6 children there and conducted a Broadcast Consultant service from there. I moved to North Dakota in November of 1990. I was Chief Engineer for an ABC TV station in Bismarck and a satellite in Minot until October of 1998, at which time I became employed with Cumulus Broadcasting and have several radio stations that I take care of.

As a SWL'er I don't know if you are at all interested in Amateur radio. In the mid 70's myself, Doug Grover, Tom Giles and Ed Lee started the Northern Lakes Amateur Radio Club. (NLARC) It is still active and I am a lifetime member with them yet. They are still very active with civic chores.
