Hi John:

Thank you for your reception report. Sounds like you did pick up the station and I enclose one of our KCSP Royals schedules for confirmation. KCSP (formerly WDAF) is a 5000 watt non-directional station operating out of Leewood, Kansas which is just across the state line from Kansas City, Missouri. The tower is a guyed unit that stands about 350 feet tall. We use a Harris Gates Five 5000 watt transmitter. Our backup is a Harris MW5B.

This is to confirm your reception of KCSP on 09-24-09 at 11:54 pm thru 9-25-09 at 12:06 am CDT. The programming you heard and logged was ours. Joslin Jewelry is one of our Kansas City sponsors. We do broadcast Kansas Jayhawks sports.

I used to DX myself. It's how I got started in this business. Using an old 1947 Philco fed with a long copper wire between two trees. I logged over 200 stations on the AM band in Independence, Missouri in the 1970's.

I have spent some time in Northern Minnesota at Bemidji on Turtle Lake. I used to attend an annual church camp function up there in the 1970's. It's where I met my wife Gail.
