It is with pleasure that I confirm your reception of KFI on 26 September 2009.

KFI is using a Harris DX-50 Solid State transmitter. It produces 50,000 watts into a tower some 650 ft. tall, with a capacitive 'top hat' to make the tower electrically taller.

The tower is 20 mi. South of Los Angeles, in a small community called La Mirada. It's just 5 miles from Disneyland!! The transmitter site was built in 1931.

Thanks so much for your interest in KFI. It truly is a legacy station which has been serving much of the western United States since 1925.
