Dear Mr. Sampson,

Thank you for your letter reporting reception of radio station KFXN on 690 kHz in Minneapolis on June 7, 1999. KFXN only operates at 500 watts with a directional antenna system producing very little signal in your direction. Although I get quite a few reports for KFAN it is rare to get reception reports for KFXN.

At one time in the past there was some research done on getting a night time signal on the air. Although it is possible, the project would be at great cost for little benefit. The transmitter would need to be relocated and a complex directional antenna system would be required. In the past year we reviewed the possibility from some different angles and again determined it was not a worthwhile project to pursue.

Your reception report is accurate. I am glad you liked the sign-off!
