Dear Mr. Crider:

Last September, I received a portion of KLMO's broadcasts on 1060 kHz. At that time, I submitted a reception report outlining what I had heard on KLMO from my location (about 175 miles north of Minneapolis). Since I haven't received a confirmation as yet, it appears that my report went astray somewhere along the line. I am very anxious to add KLMO to my list of confirmed AM broadcast stations and so am submitting my report again.

My hobby is listening to the standard AM Broadcast Band for radio stations, writing to the stations informing them of my reception and requesting a confirmation of this reception. I have collected over 3000 such confirmations from different stations and would prize a KLMO confirmation to add to this.

Items and announcements I heard over KLMO on Saturday, September 6, 2003, from 7:49 PM to 8:00 PM (Mountain Daylight Time) follow:

- 7:49 When I tuned in, the broadcast of a NASCAR Auto Race from Richmond was in progress
- 7:58 Break from the race and ad for Purifoy Chevrolet in Ft. Lupton
- 7:59 Ad for Steve's Alignment in Longmont, followed by announcement by Neil A. Gold (I'm not entirely sure of the last name) that for NASCAR coverage, keep tuned to the Radio Colorado Network and a return to the race
- 8:00 Break from the race for a station ID, which was "KLMO, Longmont, Denver; KSKE, Vail, Breckenridge, Keystone; KDMN, Buena Vista, Salida; KWYD, Colorado Springs; the Radio Colorado network" and return to the race.

I used a Collins UR388 receiver with two foot amplified loop antenna to receive KLMO. Your signal was very strong and on top of 1060. Normally, KYW, Philadelphia, dominates 1060 here at night, however, nothing from the East Coast was audible last night (which is most unusual). There was also interference from one or two others but I wasn't able to identify who they were.

May I suggest a confirmation format; a handwritten note, such as this, on your KLMO letterhead:

"Mr. Sampson:

Now KRCN

This will confirm your reception of KLMO on September 6, 2003.


