Radio Station KNFX:

On Sunday, 8:20 PM to 8:23 PM (Central Daylight Time), it was my pleasure to monitor a brief portion of the transmissions of KNFX on 970 kHz from my location, which is about 10 miles south of Grand Rapids. As proof of this reception, I offer the following listing of items I heard:

- 8:20 As you became audible, an announcement concerning Pizza and Coca Cola (an ad?) was ending
- 8:21 Announcement that "if your organization has an upcoming event that they want to be announced on the radio, please send the information to Clear Channel Communications, care of Judy Anderson, 1530 Greenview Drive SW, Suite 200, Rochester, Minnesota, 55902" and that "we're happy to help from news radio 970, KNFX", followed by an announcement concerning the National Child ID Program
- 8:22 "Rochester's News Radio 970, KNFX Forecast" and a weather forecast
- 8:23 Return to "The Dolans" program

I used a Collins UR388 receiver with two foot amplified loop antenna to receive KNFX. Your signal was on top of 970 during the time above but after you faded, I was unable to hear any more attributable to you. There was heavy interference from KXTP, Superior, and WDAY, Fargo, both of whom normally dominate 970 here during the day. I was surprised and happy to hear KNFX since I didn't think you sent much power up this way. Also, I was surprised to hear the Clear Channel affiliation since I own stock in the Company.

On the basis of the above details, I wish to request a brief letter confirming the fact that I indeed received your station's signals. I collect these letters as a hobby and have some 3000 at present. I would greatly appreciate a letter from KNFX to add to my collection. In fact, a statement, such as

"Mr. Sampson:

This will confirm your reception of KNFX on May 27, 2001.

on KNFX's letterhead would be ideal. For your convenience in replying, I have enclosed a self-addressed, stamped envelope.
