Radio Station KNOX:

On Friday, July 24, 1998, from 4:10 PM to 4:26 PM (Central Daylight Time), it was my pleasure to monitor a portion of the transmissions of KNOX on 1310 kHz from my location, which is about 10 miles south of Grand Rapids. As proof of this reception, I offer the following listing of items I heard:

- 4:10 Ad for JoJo's Hair Boutique, followed by an ad for the Marshall County Fair in Warren
- 4:11 The KNOX Marquee with Leslie Morgan
- 4:12 Announcement of the time followed by a rundown of current motion pictures
- 4:19 Talking about the Emmy Awards
- 4:21 Ad for "The Wizard of Ad" Book
- 4:22 Ad for Certa Mattresses at a local store whose name I couldn't catch, followed by an ad for Landry Heating, Cooling and Plumbing and then for the Mattress Factory
- 4:24 Announcement ("Information Radio - KNOX") and return to the KNOX Marquee and Weird News
- 4:26 KNOX closing market report

I used a Collins UR388 receiver with two foot amplified loop antenna to receive KNOX. Your signal is fairly strong but subject to considerable splatter from local KOSY on 1320. I was able to null them with the loop antenna in order to hear you.

On the basis of the above details, I wish to request a brief letter confirming the fact that I indeed received your station's signals. I collect these letters as a hobby and have some 3000 at present. I would greatly appreciate a letter from KNOX to add to my collection. In fact, a statement, such as

"Mr. Sampson:

This will confirm your reception of KNOX on July 24, 1998.

(signature)"
