- 4:24 Announcement ("Information Radio KNOX") and return to the KNOX Marquee and Weird News
- 4:26 KNOX closing market report

I used a Collins UR388 receiver with two foot amplified loop antenna to receive KNOX. Your signal is fairly strong but subject to considerable splatter from local KOSY on 1320. I was able to null them with the loop antenna in order to hear you.
