Greetings John,

I have received your letter regarding the reception of WCLO's signal from your location on September 16<sup>th</sup>, 2001, and can confirm that what you have observed is WCLO. WCLO is a 1000 watt AM station broadcasting from a Blaw Knox brand self-supporting, shunt fed tower. The tower was designed and erected in 1941, originally for WTMJ in Milwaukee, WI. This company purchased that tower from WTMJ in the 1960's and relocated it to Janesville, WI. During the time period that you had received this signal we were in the process of performing structural upgrades on the tower. The next evening the tower was de-energized for the steel-work phase of the upgrade. Broadcasting continued from a long-wire antenna draped between the top of the normal tower and a 60 foot temporary tower. The third week of October, broadcasting from the main tower resumed.
