
We're pleased to verify your reception report of August 17th.

It is rather surprising that signals of CHLO RADIO and CKGB in Timmins could be heard through the pattern laid down in your area by CJOB, Winnipeg. CJOB must have a border protection requirement.

For your information, this station uses Northern Electric transmitters, (1 kw. output) into a 4 tower directional antenna array. Ours is a cardioid pattern with a north-south orientation. Listenership is concentrated mainly in the various counties of Southwestern Ontario with frequent reception reports and other listener mail coming from points in northern Ohio and eastern Michigan.

The enclosed map outlines an approximation of this station's 0.5 m.v.m. coverage contour.
