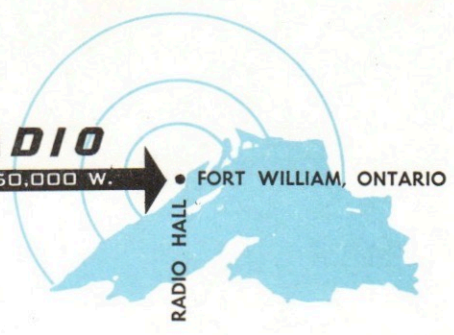

Mr. Ross, our Chief Engineer has asked me to write you a confirmation of your reception of RADIO STATION CKPR. I do hope I can be of help.

Your reception of CKPR on November 21, was quite accurate. The two announcers were Hal Lee Jr. and George Reid.

Until recently we have been operating with a 250 watt transmitter. During the middle of April we changed our location and increased our power to 48,000 ERP.

I am glad to know you are receiving our signal in S Hutchinson. Your comments from time to time would be much appreciated.

At the moment we are programming FM and AM simultaneously from 2:00 in the afternoon to 11:00 in the evening. Early in the summer we hope to have separate FM programming.

I am enclosing a rough sketch of our tower of Mt. Baldy.
