For your further information, KCKN operates on 1340 kc with a power of 250 watts with a Gates transmitter of the regular factory lash-up with a non directional antenna.

For more on the technical side, I'm sure our chief engineer, Marvin Brettemier would be happy to hear from you.

I note that you received us from 4:15 to 4:29 AM. As you probably know, we take transmitter readings each half hour. I note by my FCC log that at 4:28 AM, I reset the transmitter tuning from 2.66 to 2.65.

It was good to see a Minnesota post mark and return address, inasmuch as St. Paul is my home town. I worked with KSTP for some time, beginning in 1937 through their TV installations, both experimental and commercial until 1950.
