It is a pleasure to acknowledge your reception report of December 31, 1961 and I take this opportunity to express our sincere appreciation for your interest in KIQS ("kicks"), Willows, California. Please accept my apologies for being so remiss in replying to your report, however, we have all been working long hours, including weekends, to get the operation working smoothly.

For your information, KIQS operates with a power of 250 watts from sunrise to sunset. Transmitter: RCA, 250 watts. Antenna: non-directional, vertical, 145 feet high. Ground System: 120 radials, 160 feet long. Ground Conductivity: Very high in this area. We are located in the Valley of the Sacramento River and the surrounding terrain is extremely flat in all directions for at least 20 miles.

Again, thank you very much for your encouraging report and for taking the time to write to KIQS.
