From 6:59 PM to 7:00 PM (CST) on May 3, 1961, I heard the following on KSIS on 1050 kcs.

6:59 Ad for R.C. Cola
7:00 Sign off announcement - "And so radio station KSIS comes to the close of another broadcast day. Radio station KSIS is owned & operated by the Yates Broadcasting Co. ~~KSIS~~ KSIS radio operates on an assigned ^{free channel} ~~frequency~~ of 1050 kcs., with a daytime transmitter power of 1000 watts, by authorization of the FCC. in Washington DC. This is Wes Rydne (?), on behalf of the staff & management bidding you one & all a very pleasant good evening, & inviting you to join us at 6 tomorrow morning for news & weather. Good evening." & KSIS left the air.

There was little station interference, & KSIS was easy to hear (semi local KLOH was off the air). I used a tape recorder to get KSIS' sign off announcement. I used a Hammarlund HQ-129-X, with 4 1/2 foot (diagonal) loop antenna.

I would greatly appreciate a verification of reception from KSIS. I'm enclosing return postage for your convenience in replying.
