Than you for the report on hearing our sign on November 6, 1961. We have been getting several reports on DX reception during our sign on and also receive report that shortly after there are several other stations that sign on and take us out of the picture. This can be expected though because we have only 250 watts of radiated power.

The station utilizes four towers at night during nighttime operation, which was in operation at the time of your reception, our maximum power is directed off the end of the towers which directs it toward you.

During daytime operation we use two of the center towers..

Our FM station has and ERP of 4500 watts and we feed simulcast to both transmitters.
