From 7:31 AM to 7:32 1/2 PM, Eastern Standard Time on Sunday, January 14, 1962

I was quite pleased to hear station WEND broadcasting on a frequency of 1580 kcs. Programming I heard was as follows:

- 7:31 Announcement of the time, & announcement - "This is the Allegheny Radio Network"
- 7:32 Recorded musical station ID & "Let's go, go, go everybody with living radio," etc) then start of news from wires of UPI & WEND news room).
- 7:32 1/2 WEND faded

I would really appreciate a verification from WEND, since you are one of my best catches.

I used a Hammarlund HQ-129-X receiver with 4 1/2 foot (diagonal) loop antenna. Interference was extremely heavy from several stations.
Weather conditions were cloudy & 15°. I would greatly appreciate a verification of reception from WEND (on your letterhead stationery, if possible). I am enclosing return postage for your convenience in replying. I would also appreciate information concerning your antenna system and pattern.
