Thank you for your letter of May 10, 1961 telling of reception of WIGM on that date. Your report is sufficiently accurate, and this letter is a verification of your report.

Station WIGM is located at the edge of the city of Medford a town of 3300 population, and our power was recently increased to 1000 watts in March. We are presently operating on our program test authority. Our new transmitter is a Collins, and most of our other equipment is RCA.

This station has been on the air since 1941, and the studios and transmitter are housed in the same building. Our antenna is 155 feet guyed, located in a swamp.
