Dear Mr. Sampson;

Am Sorry about your letter not being answered last year. However, It must have been misplaced somewhere here at WLBI. We moved our Studios about that time & It may have gotten lost.

I hope this will verify your reception of WLBI on October 30, 1960. WLBI Uses a single vertical Series Fed radiator 150' in height and operates Daytime only. We have Collins Equipment from Turntables to Transmission Line. We also operate KAPB, Marksville, La. 1370 Kcs & it uses the same equipment except 1Kw Transmitter. You might Try & pick it up one morning. It comes on the air at 5 AM CST the year round & is also daytime only. Both Stations are Non-directional.

Incidentally I was in Minnesota recently at Rochester going through the Mayo Clinic. I found the country there beautiful & if I did not have such great property holdings here in La. I would be tempted to move up there. The summers are wonderful & Cool. BUT I'm afraid of your terrifically Cold & Long winters.

I hope this will fill your requirements & requests. We expect to Build another Station At New Roads, La. 1500 Kcs 1 Kw Daytime in the next two or three months. Watch for when the FCC okays our CP.
