We are indeed pleased to hear from you with your report on the reception of our station on August 27, 1961

Your information is correct with the exception that in our sign on we do not mention the population of this town (1200) and also the announcer is Kenn Bell not Eugene Bell which you indicated as unsure of.

Our antenna system consists of a 132 foot guyed tower with a radial system acting as the ground. Our pattern is non directional although it seems like most of our signal heads east from Riverhead. Our coverage is predominantly eastern Long Island which includes most of Suffolk County with reception being reported across Long Island sound.
