Thank you for your reception report of station CJRB from 03.55 - 04.07 Central Time on August 14, 1992.

CJRB broadcasts on 1220 kHz at 10 kwatts 24 hours a day. The transmitter is a Continental Electronics 316F and is located near Boissevain, Manitoba (240 kms SW of Winnipeg). It operates into a four tower array. CJRB is one of four stations that make up Radio Southern Manitoba. The other three stations are CFAM, 950 kHz and CHSM, 1250 kHz and CKMW, 1570 kHz.

Radio Southern Manitoba is owned and operated by Golden West Broadcasting Ltd who have their head offices in Altona, MB.

Thank you again for your letter and we wish you continued success in listening to distant stations. Perhaps you will have opportunity to listen to some of our other stations.
