Radio Station KDDR:

On Monday, March 11, 1991, from 8:13 AM to 8:29 AM (Central Time) it was my pleasure to monitor the transmissions of KDDR on 1220 AM. As a result of this reception, I offer the following log of items I heard:

- 8:13: The "Prevention Health Report" was in progress as I tuned in.
- 8:14: 1-2: An ad for something (color signal was quite faint at 8:14 AM and I was unable to hear what was being advertised).
- 8:15: An ad for an IBM 11 (color signal was quite faint at 8:15 AM).
- 8:16: 1-2: Weather on the Dakota Network with Steve Carlson (color signal became much stronger during this).
- 8:17: Message concerning a donation from the National Citizens Commission on Alcoholism and the Advertising Council.
- 8:18: Extended weather forecast.
- 8:19: Ad for an open house, Wednesday, March 20 from 11 AM to 1:30 PM at the Paramount 11 building that has the name "Cool 20" (color signal was an ad for the "house of 7-11" (color signal was quite faint at 8:19 AM).
- 8:20: Sports News (the faded during this, between 8:21 and 8:22).
- 8:21: 1-2: An ad for automobiles at a dealer whose phone number was 228-7307, followed by an ad for heavy duty (color signal was quite faint at 8:21 AM).
- 8:22: 1-2: Sports news from the Dakota Sports Network with Steve Carlson (color signal was quite faint at 8:22 AM).
- 8:23: 1-2: Sports news from the Dakota Sports Network with Steve Carlson (color signal was quite faint at 8:23 AM).
- 8:24: 1-2: Sports news from the Dakota Sports Network with Steve Carlson (color signal was quite faint at 8:24 AM).
- 8:25: 1-2: Sports news from the Dakota Sports Network with Steve Carlson (color signal was quite faint at 8:25 AM).

I own a Collins GR300 receiver with two feet amplified (two antennas to receive AM). Your signal was clearly strong during portions of this logging, as noted above, and it was subject to such fading. You did not retransmit after 8:29. There was no interference from any other station on 1220, either local WTCN or St. Ignace, Minnesota, the state of the air, leaving 1220 open here during the reception.

On the basis of the above details, I wish to request a brief letter confirming the fact that I indeed received your station's signals. I enclose these letters as a note and have some 2500 as present. I would greatly appreciate a letter from 1220 to me to my 1000 (color signal was quite faint at 8:29 AM).
