
Many thanks for reporting the reception of KFEZ 1190 AM on November 21, 1994. The facts you stated of what you heard are correct.

You will be pleased to know that we reduce our power considerably after 5:00 P.M. to 250 watts and you can get us. Enclosed is the schedule of times we change power. At 4:55 P.M. CST on the 21st we were operating at 1,000 watts. At 5:00 PM CST we dropped to night time power of 250 watts directional to the southwest. I am surprised you could hear KFEZ.

Enclosed is our program guide showing daytime coverage. At night we barely cover the core of the city with 250 watts. The reason you heard WOWO after 5:00 P.M. is because of our reduction in power to 250 watts. There are 32 stations sharing the 1190 AM frequency in the daytime and fewer at night. I am also enclosing for your information a list of stations operating on 1190 AM.
