KMNS is a full time directional station with separate
day & night array's. We operate at 620 kHz with a power
of 1,000 watts fulltime. We are a Class III Regional
station. We use a Collins 820D2 as our Main transmitter,
with a Collins 20V2 as our auxilliary.
