Date Sunday May 23, 1982 Monitoring period 6:08 AM to 6:26 AM Central Time.

Receiving equipment: Collins R388 receiver with 2 1/2 foot loop antenna (which gives excellent directional characteristics)

Interfering stations:

*Fairly heavy from several on 1450 & from local KQRS (1440) splatter. I was able to null KQRS enough to hear KNSI & you generally dominated 1450 (except for 6:14 to 6:21)*
