Mr. Sampson,

This letter will confirm your reception of KOGA-AM (930 Khz) on January 5, 1994 from 4:11 - 4:17 pm mountain time.

KOGA operates with a 4 tower directional array. During the daytime hours we operate with 5 kilowatts into three towers in a "dogleg" arrangement producing a very broad east/west pattern. At night we operate with 500 watts into three towers which are in-line. This produces a north/south pattern.

Ogallala Broadcasting corporation also operates two 100KW FM's in Ogallala. KOGA-FM on 99.7 Mhz and KMCX-FM on 106.5 Mhz. We also have a 1KW AM (1230 Khz) and a 100KW FM (104.7 Mhz) in Sterling, CO..

I hope you enjoyed listening to our broadcasts. If you are ever in western Nebraska please stop in and we will try to arrange a tour of our facilities for you.
