
This letter will confirm your reception of KOIL on 1290 kHz, on August 23, 1993, 8:01PM-8:23PM CST.

At the time, our radio station KKAR had been moved from 1180 kHz to 1290 kHz; however the FCC had not yet officially approved the use of the KKAR callsign on 1290 kHz, so we were required to ID the station once an hour as KOIL.

I am sorry that I do not have any stationery reflecting the former dial position of KOIL on 1290 kHz, as most items of that nature were retained by the former owners of KOIL. I hope that this old letterhead showing KKAR on 1180 is an acceptable substitute.

Thanks for your reports on both KOIL and KKAR, and good luck with DXing.
