
Dear Mr. Sampson,

Thank you for writing us and inquiring about our signal and radio station. Yours is about the third such request from the Minnesota area. Unfortunately, we must report that the reason you are hearing the station in Minnesota is due to a malfunction in our antenna phase monitor, which makes it impossible for us to aim our antenna in the direction we are licensed to during the evening hours. Normally, our signal is directed to the Western area of the country. Though it is quite refreshing to hear from listeners in your area, we will soon be back to our normal pattern.

Now on to your request. The information you sent is, indeed, the information you heard on our station. For your information, the Interstate Trucker's Network is a satellite program that we carry which originates in Chicago. Our station picks up the signal at 10:00 pm MST, and carries it until 5:00 am MST. We are a fifty thousand watt station owned and operated by the Navajo Nation, or the Navajo Tribe. Our format, as you know, is Country/Western, and we play Native American music from all tribes.

Thank you once again for your interest in our station. If your travels ever bring you to the Window Rock area, or Gallup, New Mexico, then by all means, please stop in and say hello. We would enjoy that very much.
