Dear Mr. Sampson:

Thank you for letter postmarked May 21, 1996. I must say I am most impressed with your thoroughness in noting what was going over our airwaves at the time you tuned in.

KWOM began broadcasting at 7 pm on Wednesday, May 15, 1996. We are an affiliate of ABC's Satellite Music Network, using their "Stardust" format. We broadcast live from our Watertown studio from 5 am to 6 pm Monday through Friday, and from 6am to 1 pm on Saturday and Sunday. The remainder of each day we use the satellite service.

Regarding your request for information on our antenna configuration, I'll provide as much information as I can, although from your letter, I can tell that you know much more about radio equipment than I. Our transmitter and tower site is about 1 mile northwest of the city of St. Bonifacius. We have three, 150-foot towers that provide a north and northeastward directional signal. We broadcast at a power of 5000 watts at a frequency of 1600 kHz.

Also, to aid in your collection of letters...

I hereby confirm your reception of KWOM, 1600 AM, on May 19, 1996.

Again, thank you for writing and feel free to tune in anytime.
