This is to confirm your reception of WMBI (AM) on Thursday, December 9, 1993 at approximately 4:10 PM CST.

WMBI is owned and operated by the Moody Bible Institute of Chicago. Operations commenced in 1926.

WMBI broadcasts with a power of 5,000 watts from a 500 foot Blaw-Knox tower located in Addison, IL - 19 miles west of Chicago.

Your letter of December 9 shows that the station left the air at 4:15PM. This is because of our day time license. The dominant stations on 1110 kHz are KFAB in Omaha and WBT in Charlotte. Since you are closer to Nebraska, you heard KFAB competing during the critical hours.

Thanks for listening and for your report. It's always nice to hear that the signal of WMBI travels long distances.
