We are, indeed, WMIN Radio. We received this call letter change May 1. WMIN Radio went off the air at 1030 AM on January 15 of this year. Our company acquired lease rights to AM 630 WDGY and went back on the air Feb. 15 with our same original hits format. We retained rights to the WMIN call letters after selling 1030 to WCTS FM. We transferred those call letters to our sister station in Hudson.
