
Thank you for your letter. The information you included in your correspondence was correct and accurate. With this in mind, we're pleased to confirm your reception report.

WTIC AM is the fifty-thousand watt AM sister station to WTIC-FM (96-TIC) with a nighttime directional pattern (non-directional daytime) operating on the clear channel frequency of 1080 kHz. WTIC AM officially began broadcasting on February 10, 1925 (500 watts on 630 kHz). The station went to 50 kilowatts in 1930 on 1060 kHz, and after several schedule, power and frequency changes finally realized full power on its present frequency in 1940.

WTIC prides itself on its reputation throughout the east coast of the United States as a high quality and dependable source of news, sports, weather information and entertaining talk radio.
