Thank you for your accurate reception report of 12/30/93. I'm very sorry for the delay in answering it, but we have had some serious technical problems related to the weather.

WWVA operates with a single tower during the daylight hours and transfers to a 3 tower array after sunset. We then beam our signal 77 degrees from true north. This is done so that we can protect KVOO in Tulsa, Ok. It seems you were picking us up from a side lobe.

It is always good to hear from DXers all over the US & Canada. We also receive quite a few reports from Sweden & Finland.

If you should travel down this way, please let me know when & I will give you the grand tour of our studio & transmitter site.

Again, thank you for taking the time to send your report. I do very much appreciate it.
