Dear John:

This letter is to confirm or QSL your reception and logging of WERA on Wednesday, March 14, 1973, from 12:07 until 12:22 pm EST.

WERA is a 500 watt, directional antennae, daytime only station, with studio's and offices located in the Park Hotel Annex, Plainfield, and transmitter on Oak Tree Rd in South Plainfield.

We transmit a figure eight pattern in a North-South direction, using three in-line, 140 ft towers. Our transmitters are RCA type BTA-1R, 1000 watt units operated at half power. We broadcast from 6:00am until local sundown seven days a week. The station began operation in Sept 1961.

We thank you for your comments and interest. I have enclosed a coverage map, and hope that it, along with the above information will answer most all of your questions. If you are ever in our area, and would like to see our installation, you may drop in anytime during normal programming hours. We would enjoy talking with you.
