John:

Here is the WFSR QSL card. I have sent about 4 out, however ~~the~~ yours is the only one for the 2 ~~June~~ June broadcast. About 2 other National Radio Club members have them.

WFSR, along with WKOV started the Falling Star Network ~~about~~ 3 years ago. after being on the air for about 6 months or so, (on 1620 kHz, alternate days) WKOV added WXMN (FM) at 108.1 MHz. WFSR (the station run by myself was planning to add FM at 108.1, however [WKOV/WXMN (Allan Weiner)] & I decided that 108.1 was a bad frequency (since it's in the aircraft band), ~~so~~ we shifted to 87.9 MHz, and the call WFSR-FM was not used, ~~was~~ instead it became WSEX-FM. Both FM stations started out with a power of 50 watts, which was later increased to 250. WKOV-AM started with 50 watts, WFSR-AM with 75, ~~both~~ both ~~later~~ later became 300. Each station later simulcasted, (WKOV-AM & WXMN-FM) and (WFSR-AM & WSEX-FM). After over 13 months of broadcasting, almost every day, we got busted by the FCC, you must ~~have~~ have heard all about it. The transmitters used were: WKOV, BC-1100 (50 watts) and later the BC-610 (300 watts). WFSR, BC 191 (75 watts) later, the BC-610 (300 watts). WSEX & WXMN, TRC-1, (50 watts) ~~was~~ we later added the TRA 250 watt amplifier. (I forgot the transmitter used for 108.1) You might want to listen for these other stations:

WQLB, 87.9 MHz FM, Queens N.Y. 50 watts  
WFRB, 87.9 MHz FM, Brooklyn N.Y. 50 watts

~~Both~~ Both of these stations are on sporadically now since they are both working on station improvements.

LANESVILLE - T.V. channel 3, Lanesville N.Y. 6 watts (approx)

this station does local programming, it is surely ~~unlikely~~ unlikely that you could pick them up.

I haven't heard of ANY NEW JERSEY PIRATES, SORRY.

If you could tell me of ANY PIRATES NOW ON THE AIR, I WISH you would, for I would like to keep a loose coordination going. I AM SORRY for the sloppiness of this letter but it's late, AND MY HEAD HAS BEEN involuntarily jammed lately.
